

Testing for and controlling BVD in New Zealand herds



Individually test all animals for BVD virus



Eliminate ALL BVD virus positive animals



Annually test all calves born on to the property for BVD virus. Test as soon after birth as possible



Confirm that any animal brought on to the farm (purchased, agisted, breeding bulls, etc) is free of BVD virus



Implement biosecurity practices which help reduce the exposure of your herd to BVD



Vaccinate all breeding animals if the risk of exposure to BVD can not be eliminated
